WHEREAS, These infrastructures, facilities, and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, who are federally mandated first responders, and the engineers, managers, and employees at all levels of government and the private sector, who are responsible for rebuilding, improving, and protecting our nation's transportation, water supply, water treatment and solid waste systems, public buildings, and other essential structures and facilities; and,

WHEREAS, It is in the public interest for all in Tempe to gain knowledge and maintain ongoing interest and understanding of the importance of public works first responders and public works programs in their respective communities; and,

WHEREAS, This year marks the 62nd annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association/Canadian Public Works Association; and,
